Ministry of Public Health Notification

No. 311 B.E. 2551 (2008)

Re : Prescribed Prohibited Food to be Produced, Imported or Sold

Apparently, there have been infants and small children collapsed and died in other country due to consuming foods which contain melamine and its analogues. therefore, it is urgent need to provide consumer protection.

By virtue of the provision of Section 5 and 6(8) of the Food Act B.E. 2522 (1979), which restricts personal rights and liberties in conjunction with Section 29, 33, 41, 43 and 45 of the Constitution of the Kingdom of Thailand, the Minister of Public Health according to an advice of the food committee issues the notification as follows:

1. Foods which contain melamine and its analogues (Cyanuric acid, Ammelide and Ammeline) are prohibited food to be produced, imported or sold unless they meet to the criteria which prescribed by the Food and Drug Administration by the approval of the food committee.
2. This Notification is effective the day after its announcement in the Royal Gazette.
